

Modernization in the Bjelasnica ski resort

In 2017, Bartholet will build two new installations in Bjelasnica: a fixed 4-passenger chair lift and a detachable 6-passenger chair lift. Bjelasnica in Bosnia and Herzegovina is a popular skiing and hiking area right next to the city of Sarajevo. During the Winter Olympic Games in Sarajevo in 1984, Bjelasnica was used as a venue for the men's alpine ski races.

The Bjelasnica ski resort is being modernized by a consortium with Supersnow from Poland (artificial snow solutions).
