

New Project in Moscow

Bartholet recently received the official go-ahead for a new project in Moscow. The city ropeway, a mixed system with gondolas designed by Porsche Design Studio, conveys passengers from the highest point of the city, Sparrow Hills, to the Olympic Stadium, crossing the Moskva river en route. The second section of the system will now be given 4-seater chairlifts in addition to the gondolas.

“With the new panorama gondolas designed by Porsche Design Studio this will be a cutting-edge ropeway for Moscow that will prove a worldwide sensation. We are very pleased to be able to offer our visitors a first class Swiss product, particularly for the 2018 World Cup but also throughout the year” (Moscow customer).

The ropeway is expected to begin construction on July 1, 2016 and be ready for opening at the end of 2016.
